



**Sebastian River Art Club's Annual Juried Members Exhibition -
Prospectus**

Saturday, March 19th, 2022 - 11 am to 4 pm

WHO MAY ENTER: Open to all current (2022 dues) members in good standing of the Sebastian River Art Club. Members may enter up to two pieces of Artwork. All artwork must be original, less than 3 years old, and the Artwork cannot have won a ribbon from SRAC in the past. Artwork need not be for sale. Please mark the Sales Price on the entry forms as NFS (not for sale) if the artwork is not for sale.

ENTRY FEE: \$10.00 for up to two entries per artist

FRAMING: Paintings on canvas must be framed or gallery-wrapped with at least 3/4" wrap around and painted on all 4 sides. No staples. Frames must be in new condition and have wire and D-Rings for hanging. **NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS**

LOCATION: SRAC Gallery, 1245 Main Street, Sebastian, FL 32958

APPLICATION AND FEE DUE DATE: Application and entry fee are due by Noon on Friday, March 18th

SIZE: Artists' whose 2D work is wider than 36" must provide their own easel for display as it is too large for our panels.

3D - 3 Dimensional work will be placed on a skirted table, unless the artist supplies a substantial pedestal base.

OUTSIDE TENTS: Members are invited to set up tents outside for the duration of the show to sell other original artwork, prints, cards, etc. The fee for tent space is \$10.00 for Artists and Crafters. Sign up for tent space rental at the February Business Meeting or anytime during regular club hours, Tuesdays and Thursdays 11-3.

ART INTAKE: Thursday, March 17th from 11-3 and Friday: March 18th from 10am to Noon.

ART PICKUP: Saturday, March 19th 4:00 PM at the closing of the show.

RECEPTION: Lite Refreshments will be available during the show.

AWARDS: Best of Show, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place Ribbons in the following categories: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, 3D, Mixed Media, Drawing, Photography and Other. **Under-represented mediums (less than 5 entries in a category) will be combined together in the "Other" Category.**

JUDGING: This year's judge is Linda Spencer of Vero Beach, Florida and Central Massachusetts.

After retiring from 35 years of teaching high school art, Linda is thrilled to have the time to concentrate on her dual loves of painting and travelling.

As a certified teacher in the state of Massachusetts, she continues to teach adult art classes at a local technical school, the Massasoit Art Guild in Massachusetts, and here, in Vero Beach at McKee Botanical Gardens. Over the years, Linda has also served as a member of several Cultural Councils in Massachusetts.

She especially enjoys plein air painting, and currently paints with three different plein air painting groups while in Florida. She recently completed a plein air workshop with the Coastal Maine Art Workshops. Her love of plein air painting started at Cape Cod's Coast Guard station through courses taken at Northeastern University, in Massachusetts.

Linda has completed her BFA at the University of Massachusetts, did her student teaching in Bristol, England, and completed additional coursework at Mass Art in Boston, Anna Maria College in Paxton, MA, as well as The Worcester Massachusetts Art Museum and three Massachusetts state colleges.

All artists are responsible for collecting, filing, and paying state sales tax on any sales. If the Artwork is not for sale, no Florida Sales Tax License is needed to participate.
