**Art Pickup at ELC:** Monday, Jan 6, 2025 10am – Noon.

**Entry Fee: \$10.00 per artist payable upon entry:** Up to 2 entries per artist: The Entry Fee will be evenly divided between the SRAC Food Bank Fund and the SRAC Scholarship fund.

All Artwork must meet the ELC and SRAC Artwork and Presentation Standards

### Artwork and Presentation Requirements:

Exhibition is open to all SRAC juried artists. (Artist must sign-up on the sign-up forms in the SRAC office prior to Thursday, October 24 (close of business)).

- **All Artwork must be for sale for this exhibit.**
- Submitted Artwork must be the original work of the submitting artist in both concept and completion. No copies of, or likenesses of another artist's work, including from published sources that do not belong to the submitting artist, will be allowed.
- Theme: Nature Related Artwork
- Size limitations: None – However work must be able to be hung on a wall.
- Artwork must be able to be hung with wire using D-Rings and Wire. The apex of the wire should be 3 inches below the top of the artwork/frame. (no sawtooth hangers)
- Dust cover backing is required on framed work in the following categories: Photography, Watercolor, Pastel, Pen and Ink, Drawing, Digital Art, Mixed Media other than Oils and Acrylics. Oils and Acrylics do not require dust cover backings. Frames must be in new/like new condition.
- Gallery Wrap Canvases need to be 1.75 inches width with sides and exposed back sides painted. Backings for entries without a dust cover must not be frayed, or in poor condition.
- A waiver/drop-off/pick-up form will be available at take in to be filled out and signed during Art Drop-off on Friday, November 1st.

- The Artist permits the ELC to use photographs, artist's name, likeness, and or bio/tagline in gallery communication and advertising material for promotional purposes.
- No artworks that might be perceived as overly tasteless, hostile, slanderous, provocative, and/or culturally appropriated in ways that might be offensive are allowed.
- The Environmental Learning Center will handle all sales and FL Sales Tax Calculation, reporting and payment.
- The Environmental Learning Center will retain 30% of the sales price of Artists' work

**SRAC reserves the right to refuse any artwork for this exhibition not adhering to the above standards.**
