Applications are due no later than Close of Business on Saturday, August 24th.

Sign-ups and Entry forms are now available in the Office. Two entries per artist. Entries do not need to be for sale.

### Dates to Remember

- 8/27 & 8/29: Artwork Jury Dates: **Tuesday, August 27, and Thursday, August 29th, from noon until 2pm.**
- All artwork must be juried by SRAC jury committee and photographed for the museum paperwork.
- 9/10: - Art Drop Off: September 10<sup>th</sup> at the Vero Beach Museum of Art: 10am to 2pm  
The attached waivers must be signed and turned in with your artwork at take-in.
- Friday, 9/13: Reception: 4-6pm No Red or Rose Wine. White Wine ONLY!! Finger Food.
- Monday, 10/21 from 10am to Noon: Art Pick up: At the Vero Beach Art Museum. Failure to pick up art on time or arrange for pick-up of your art on time will result in the artist being ineligible to display in this show the following year.

**Entry Fee: \$5.00 per entry**, Maximum 2 entries per artist payable on the Jury Dates. The Entry Fee will be evenly divided between the SRAC Food Bank Fund and the SRAC Scholarship fund.

All Artwork must meet the Museum Presentation Standards (See Below) and be juried in by the SRAC Jury Committee.

**Presentation Requirements** All Artwork must meet the Museum Presentation Standards (See Below) and be juried in by the SRAC Jury Committee.

1. 2D and 3D artworks are accepted in this exhibition.
2. All 2D artworks must be gallery wrapped or framed with wire hardware using D rings ONLY (no saw tooth hangers).
3. Dust cover backing is required on framed work in the following categories: Photography, Watercolor, Pastel, Pen and Ink, Drawing, Digital Art. Oils and Acrylics do not require dust cover backings. Frames must be in new/like new condition.
4. Gallery Wrap Canvases need to be 1.75 inches width with sides and exposed back sides painted.
5. Backings for entries without a dustcover must not be frayed, or in poor condition. NEATNESS AND PRESENTATION COUNT. The SRAC jury committee has the final decision on what is acceptable.
5. Artworks must not exceed 24 x 36 inches in any direction, including frame.
6. Works of art must remain in the Patten Community Gallery of the Vero Beach Museum of Art for the duration of the exhibition. **Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES should artwork be removed prior to the end of the show. If a piece is sold, arrangements must be made through SRAC for removal of the Artwork and replacement of the artwork**
7. A waiver/drop-off/pick-up form must be filled out, signed, and returned to VBMA with at Art Take-in.
8. Prices are not permitted on artworks or labels.

*If someone is interested in purchasing an artwork, VBMA staff will let them know to contact SRAC directly.*

**\*Artworks must meet museum standards and criteria (no artworks that might be reasonably perceived as overly tasteless, hostile, slanderous, provocative, and/or culturally appropriated in ways that might be offensive.**

### Items not allowed in the museum

Soil : Live plants or natural plant/flower cuttings (*only exceptions are plants/flowers from florist; stamen from flowers need to be removed*): Materials showing evidence of mold, insects, or disease

**Glitter (includes glitter shedding items – ie glittery pipe cleaners, etc) (glitter glue is allowed)**

**LIABILITY:** Show organizers will make every effort to protect exhibited art, but cannot accept liability for loss or damage.

**SRAC reserves the right to refuse any artwork for this exhibition not adhering to the above standards.**

Artists entering the exhibit acknowledge and accept the above liability statement as well as the show rules stated above as a condition of entry by signing the entry label forms.
